Motion by Hahn and seconded by O'Reilly to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Thuman and seconded by Brunkhorst to approve the June 22, 2022, minutes. Motion carried.

Old Business Old Burts Farm Store will have a Phase 1 Study done. Meeting will be on July 20 at 10 am.

Motion by Thuman and seconded by Brunkhorst to approve a building permit to Larry Vieths. Motion carried.

Building Permit process- If you are thinking about building a project on your property, putting in a fence, landscaping, etc., we encourage you to know your property lines and call 811 before you dig. It's important to fill out a building permit before you begin. In some cases, you will need drawings of the project and may need City Council approval. The city is not responsible for your property lines, and you may need to call for a survey to find your property lines at your expense. It is important that you know this information before you begin your project. If you have questions, call city hall.
